#### Technical Priorities – Work of Soumen at EPFL

- » Update with trial clays: May
- » JK Laksmi Clinker PPC
- » Mineral gypsum
- » Calcined clay from Bhuj sent to EPFL
- » Two types of limestone: A cement grade and B waste
- » Sieved in 2 mm mesh
- » Standard LC3 blend. 50, 30, 15, 5
- » Every 5 minutes samples. 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 + 2(1 8)
- » Samples from the walls as well.
- » This if 4 kg of each of the blends
- » Same blends repeated.
